In the KENAFF Strategic Plan, 2022—2026, titled "*Watering the Tree for Growth*," seven (7) key pillars form the critical components of the federation's day-to-day planning framework. The Secretariat is pleased to inform all KENAFF members and KENAFF partners about the significant developments and progress the federation achieved in the month of May 2024.

Pilar 1: Lobby, Advocacy and Policy Action

KENAFF Advisory Mandate at the National Level

National Technical Advisory Committee (NTAC) Meeting on Emergency Locust Response Program (ELRP) which aims to restore the livelihoods of households affected by drought and desert locust invasion and to strengthen Kenya's system for preparedness.

Courtesy calls to the Ministry of Agriculture, Livestock, and Fisheries in the Counties

Courtesy call to the County Executive Member (CECM) for Agriculture, Livestock, and Fisheries Bomet County, Chief Officer for Agriculture, Livestock, Fisheries, and Irrigation, Taita Taveta County, and Sub-County Agricultural Officers (SCAO) in Msambweni, Matuga, and Kinango Sub counties, Kwale County. The courtesy calls aimed to foster partnerships and collaborations in activities and programs that aim to improve the farming environment and enhance farmers' livelihoods.

Public participation and Talk Shows

Participation in preparation of the **Uasin-Gishu County Government 2024/25 Financial Year Budget** on May 8, 2024, to lobby for more funds to be allocated to agricultural initiatives that aim at improving farmers' livelihoods.

KENAFF Uasin-Gishu County Farmers' Association leaders participated in Kass and Chamgei TV Media talk shows; to articulate farmer issues including the shortage of maize seeds and farmer-driven research innovation and technology; on May 3 and May 10, 2024, respectively.

Pillar 2: Enhanced Member Services

Capacity Building and Member Mobilization and KENAFF Farmer Health Insurance (FHI) Sensitization

31 Member mobilizations, recruitment and KENAFF Farmer Health Insurance (FHI) sensitization exercises were carried out in different KENAFF counties. During these meetings members were sensitized on the importance of speaking in one voice and belonging to a National Farmers' Organization; KENAFF, in order to articulate their interests to relevant stakeholders. The members were also sensitized on the importance of acquiring farmer health insurance.



Pillar 3: Contribute to a Sustainable Kenyan Agri-food System

KENAFF joined **Dairy Value chain** stakeholders in celebrating 2024 **International Milk Day** themed "*Celebrating the Vital Role Dairy Plays in Delivering Quality Nutrition to Nourish the World*" at KCSEED Dairy Plant in Nakuru County on May 30, 2024; **Potato Value Chain** stakeholders in celebrating the **International Day of Potato** themed "*Harvesting Diversity, Feeding the Future*" at KALRO, Ol-Jorok, Nyandarua County on May 30, 2024; and, Exhibitions and Trade Fair for the two events on May 31, 2024.

Pillar 5: Farmer-Driven Climate Action and Resilience Building against Shocks and Emergencies

KENAFF Tree Planting exercises during March-April-May (MAM), 2024 Rainfall cycle

In the month of May, **over 8,000** tree seedlings of diverse mix of indigenous species, fodder plants, and fast-maturing species were planted in various Counties: Taita Taveta, Makueni, Meru, Nakuru, Kwale, Siaya, Uasin Gishu and Nairobi Counties. Tree planting activities was in collaboration with the Nas Servair in Nairobi County, and the County Governments of Makueni and Kwale.

Pillar 6: Data Innovation and ICT in Agriculture

On May 20, 2024, at a panel discussion on the Farmers Show at KTN TV, KENAFF highlighted the role of ICT in agriculture towards enhancing food security amid climate change crisis, and how farmers can use ICT to revolutionize farming, present opportunities in ICT in Agriculture and their accessibility.

Pillar 7: Partnerships and Collaborations

Welthungerhilfe (WHH): KENAFF Partnership

Capacity Building Workshop of Duty Bearers at the National Level under the Sustainable Food Systems (SUSTFARM+) Project held at Nakuru ATC on May 28, 2024. The duty bearers from Nyamira, Bomet, Baringo, Uasin Gishu, Nakuru, and Nandi Counties were sensitized on components of food systems; the policy framework and governance; and the role of different stakeholders in food systems.

Solidaridad East and Central Africa Expertise: KENAFF Partnership

On May 13- 25, 2024, **500 lead farmers** from coffee cooperatives in Kericho, Bungoma, Bomet, Kisii, Nandi, Nyamira, and Trans-Nzoia under the Pathways to Prosperity (P2P) Coffee Programme were trained. The training, conducted by Coffee Research Institute, was on: climate-smart farming, fertilizer use, pest control and agroforestry and afforestation in coffee farming.

Between May 6-16, 2024, **registration of coffee farmers** from 10 coffee cooperatives in Kisii and Nyamira counties, 7 coffee cooperatives from Kericho County, 6 coffee cooperatives from Bungoma County and 12 cooperatives from Trans Nzoia was carried out under the Pathways to Prosperity (P2P) Coffee Programme.
